We will confirm all appointment times this week. If the meetings are held online, log in details and joining information will be sent to you, in advance.

COVID-19 ENHANCED PRECAUTIONS

Unfortunately over the last week our school has seen a dramatic increase in the number of positive COVID-19 cases. As a result we have had to reintroduce some COVID-19 protocols, including additional cleaning of touch points and frequent areas of use, class worship rather than collective worship and all adults in school are wearing face masks in corridors and public areas

If you have any positive COVID cases within your household, all children must be taken for a PCR test and they should only return to school once a negative test result has been received.

As children are displaying a variety of different symptoms, we request that if your child is unwell, you arrange for them to have a PCR test. We understand that there are the usual seasonal bugs around, however, it is proving difficult to separate the common cold from COVID-19 in a lot of cases.

Adults must wear a mask in school, this includes the Reception Area and when speaking to members of staff.
