- Our school day ends at 3.15pm. Please pick up your child from the infant playground. A wave is always helpful in the crowd, both for staff and the children.
- Your child will do PE every Wednesday. On this day please bring your child to school in their PE kit, with school jumper/cardigan and trainers.
A pair of tracksuit bottoms, dark in colour, may be worn. (Uniform policy)
- Your child will take part in **Muddy Monday (Forest School sessions)** on Monday afternoons. Please send children with a pair of wellies/appropriate footwear to leave in school for use in this session. The session takes place in the Eco Zone in all weathers so waterproofs/wetsuits can also be kept in school on your child's peg. As the weather gets colder you may wish to send layers in for particular sessions, which do not need to be kept in school.
- If your child is having a school lunch, please see the school website for the daily menu choice. It is helpful if you can discuss the choice with your child before school so they are confident about what they will choose at the point of ordering.
- We do provide children with a piece of fruit each day, however if your child wishes to bring their own fruit of choice, that is fine.
- May I remind you all we have a child in class with a serious **PEANUT ALLERGY** which could be life threatening. Many of you have asked about sending cakes or treats in for Birthdays. I ask that you do not send anything in which contains NUTS and that anything sent in is sent in the packaging so that I can check the ingredients myself. Thank you for this in advance.

We have been delighted to see how confident and happy your children have been starting school and we look forward to all the learning that will take place this year!
